St Seraphim's Trust, housed in the old railway station in Little Walsingham, is home to a collection of icons and icon painting materials, a Pilgrim Chapel in the Byzantine Style and a Quiet Garden. Through looking after and displaying its collections, the Trust seeks to share its enchanting heritage with visitors of all ages.

As part of our HLF funded '*Volunteering at St Seraphim's Trust: displaying icons and reaching new communities*', we are looking for an enthusiastic Volunteer Coordinator who will recruit and develop volunteers to support the delivery of new activities in the icon gallery and Quiet Garden, manage and catalogue collections and act as stewards/welcomers. This hands-on opportunity will also provide the chance to support the refurbishment of our new icon gallery.

The right candidate will be enthusiastic, have excellent communication skills and a willingness to learn about the collections and mission of St Seraphim's Trust. They will be self-motivated and keen to see a project through from start to finish, following the Trust's HLF Project Plan.
